Description

Rapier called Pappenheim, probably Spanish, with asymmetrical shell, 17th century.

Donkey-stepped mount with flattened rivet knob pommel and unfixed knuckle bow at pommel.

Guard branch and inverted quillon in an "S" with a large ricasso donkey step, on a solid

asymmetrical shell with line decoration, called "BOCA DE CABELLO" (horse's mouth). Flat

blade with 2 cutting edges and central throat at two thirds of 44 cm. Wooden pommel. Total

length: 109 cm Blade length: 87 cm Blade width at the heel: 2.7 cm Length of the ricasso: 5 cm

Width at the height of the quillons: 20 cm Good
