This curved furniture has two doors opening with offset brass lighters on the sides, and a glazed door encircled with brass and mounted on brass hinges as well. This central showcase with two glass shelves gives the possibility of highlighting beautiful pieces while allowing them to be protected. The two solid doors reveal a spacious storage space with shelves. The Satinwood interior brings an elegant finish to this rare sideboard. All locks and keys are original and in perfect working order. This shimmering piece of furniture is characterized in particular by its rounded sides underlined by a wooden element shaped with 6 grooves. The doors are also embellished with blackened wooden frames. This
