Very attractive portrait from the Louis XV period, representing a high-ranking military officer of the old regime, supposedly "Colonel of the brigade", wearing his decoration of Knight of the military and royal order of Saint-Louis, and the number 47 on the buttons of his uniform. This handsome man, represented from the front with his head turned to his left in military uniform, with a powdered hairstyle with a single hammer on the horizontal side, revealing the black ribbon of his rosette at the back, exteriorizes the expression of the benevolent force and values.
