Two handles on the sides join the foot, decorated with flowers and leaves, which is marked "H. Vian" on its base for the famous founder Henri Vian (1858-1904).

Grandfather of the writer Boris Vian, Henri Vian is one of the great bronziers of the second half of the 19th century. Installed in the Salé hotel, current Picasso museum, at 5 rue de Thorigny in Paris, he participated in the Universal Exhibitions of 1878 and 1889 in the class "art bronzes, various art cast irons, art ironwork, repoussé metals
